

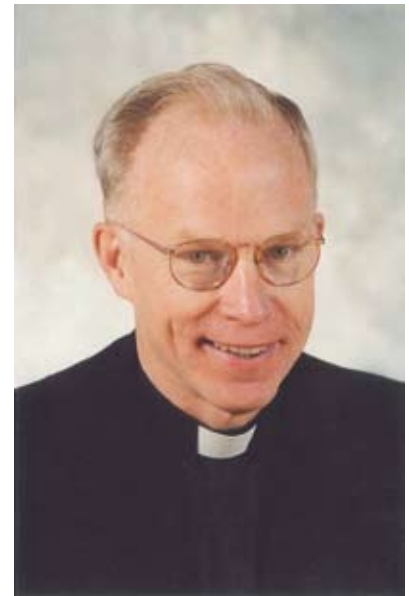

*Father John M. McDermott, S.J. was born in the Bronx on November 8, 1942, entered the Society of Jesus in 1961. He was ordained a priest in 1971. His studies were at Fordham University (A.B.), Hochschule Sankt Georgen in Frankfurt, Germany (S.T.L), and the Gregorian University in Rome (S.T.L). He taught for 12 years at Fordham University, another twelve at the Gregorian University, seven at the Pontifical College Josephinum in Columbus, Ohio, and three and a half at Sacred Heart Seminary. He has been a member of the International Theological Commission (2003-009) and currently a consultant for the American Bishops’ Committee on Doctrine. He has published two books: **Love and Understanding: The Relation of Will and Intellect in Pierre Rousselot’s Christological Vision** (1982) and **The Bible on Human Suffering** (1990) as well as more than 125 articles on various theological topics.*
